ORDER

As per the Government Orders read above, the Deputy Director General of NCC of Brigadier rank, who was the senior most Army Officer and the head of all NCC personnel in Kerala and Lakshadweep NCC Directorate, was delegated all the powers of Head of Department. In 2013, a post of Additional Director General in the rank of Major General was created by the Integrated Headquarters of Ministry of Defence (Army) as Head of all NCC personnel in Kerala and Lakshadweep Directorate. Being the senior most Army Officer and the Head of all NCC personnel of Kerala and Lakshadweep Directorate, the Additional Director General has been performing all the duties of Head of Department of NCC Department with effect from 19th March 2013. Since no change has been made to the Government orders read above, some difficulties on utilizing the administrative powers including disciplinary powers were experienced which led to litigation and hence the Additional Director General NCC as per the letter read 5th paper above has requested to take steps to re-designate the 'Additional Director General' as the Head of NCC Department and to make necessary amendments in Government Records.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to re-designate the Additional Director General, NCC as the Head of NCC Department with effect from 19-03-2013.

3. All the administrative, financial and functional powers vested with the Deputy Director General, NCC as Head of Department has been treated as delegated to the Additional Director General with effect from 19-03-2013.

4. Necessary amendments in the Codes and Manuals will be made later.


