The following shall be the guidelines for awarding grace marks.

1. Cadet should attend 75% of the NCC activities of a year.
2. Grace marks shall be given for all the theory papers/subjects of a course in a year irrespective of whether the course is annual for semesters.
3. In the case of both Semester courses and annual courses the academic year shall be taken into account. For Semester Course the percentage shall be the same as applicable to the annual scheme.
4. Grace marks shall be calculated on the basis of the aggregate marks of the year of participation and shall be awarded to the best advantage of the students to the theory paper in the respective year.

5. The student shall claim the grace marks before the end of the respective semesters within the academic year.
6. Grace marks shall be awarded only for written examination for the first appearance.
7. Grace marks awarded shall not be considered for ranking.
8. The maximum grace marks awarded to a student in a particular year is limited to 5% of aggregate marks.
